<b>Description</b> Reporting, disclosure, and practitioner review requirements under the prescription drug monitoring program; providing an exemption from emergency rule procedures; and granting rule-making authority					

### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill makes changes to the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program which is administered by the Controlled Substances Board. The changes include the disclosure to prosecutors of monitored prescription drugs that have been dispensed at a pharmacy or by a practitioner. In addition, prosecutors may submit a written request for such data if they are involved in an active and specific investigation or prosecution of a violation of law involving a monitored prescription drug, or as part of a drug court.

Prosecutors do not anticipate a fiscal effect on their offices if this bill is enacted.

### Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Prosecutors do not expect there to be a long-term fiscal effect should this bill be enacted.
