2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 119

Assembly Bill 119 prohibits an insurer that issues a motor vehicle insurance policy that covers repairs to a motor vehicle from: (1) requiring that repairs must be made by a particular contractor or repair facility as a condition of that coverage; or (2) failing to initiate or conclude with due dispatch an investigation of a claim for repairs on the basis of whether the repair will be made by a particular contractor or repair facility.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 specifies that an insurer is prohibited from both failing to initiate **and** failing to conclude with due dispatch an investigation of a claim for repairs on the basis of whether the repair will be made by a particular contractor or repair facility.

BILL HISTORY

Representative E. Brooks offered Assembly Amendment 1 on April 29, 2015. On October 22, 2015, the Assembly Committee on Insurance recommended adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 15, Noes, 0, and recommended passage of Assembly Bill 119, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 14; Noes, 1.
