2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 242

Assembly Bill 242 modifies current administrative rules regarding storage, sterilization, and the timing of replacement of oxygen equipment used at a nursing home resident's bedside to require that the equipment be maintained and used in accordance with current standards of practice and manufacturers' recommendations.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 adds a provision to the bill that modifies current administrative rules regarding storage, sterilization, and the timing of replacement of oxygen equipment used at a facility serving people with developmental disabilities to require that the equipment be maintained and used in accordance with current standards of practice and manufacturers' recommendations.

BILL HISTORY

Representative Bernier offered Assembly Amendment 1 to Assembly Bill 242 on September 3, 2015. On September 18, 2015, the Assembly Committee on Health voted to recommend adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 10; Noes, 1, and passage of Assembly Bill 242, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 10; Noes, 1.
