2015 SENATE BILL 93

Senate Bill 93 prohibits an insurer that issues a motor vehicle insurance policy that covers repairs to a motor vehicle from: (1) requiring that repairs must be made by a particular contractor or repair facility as a condition of that coverage; or (2) failing to initiate or conclude with due dispatch an investigation of a claim for repairs on the basis of whether the repair will be made by a particular contractor or repair facility.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 to Senate Bill 93 clarifies that an insurer is prohibited from both failing to initiate, **and** failing to conclude, with due dispatch an investigation of a claim for repairs on the basis of whether the repair will be made by a particular contractor or repair facility.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Marklein offered Senate Amendment 1 to Senate Bill 93 on April 29, 2015. On May 29, 2015, the Senate Committee on Insurance, Housing, and Trade voted unanimously to recommend adoption of Senate Amendment 1 and passage of Senate Bill 93, as amended.
