2015 SENATE BILL 251

September 4, 2015 - Introduced by Senators LAZICH and MILLER, cosponsored by Representative E. BROOKS. Referred to Committee on Public Benefit and Regulatory Reform.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 14.86 (1) (b) and (c) of the statutes; **relating to:** terms of office
2 for members of the Midwest Interstate Passenger Rail Commission.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law adopts the midwest interstate passenger rail compact and creates a Midwest Interstate Passenger Rail Commission. Among the members of the commission are one representative to the assembly, appointed by the speaker of the assembly for a two-year term, and one senator appointed by the president of the senate for a two-year term. The compact, as enacted into state law, specifies that the members of the commission must include two legislators, one from each house, who shall serve two-year terms, or until successors are appointed.

This bill clarifies that the legislative members of the commission serve two-year terms, or until successors are appointed.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 14.86 (1) (b) and (c) of the statutes are amended to read:
4 14.86 (1) (b) One representative to the assembly, appointed by the speaker of
5 the assembly for a 2-year term, or until a successor is appointed.
