Proposed Rules Relating to Unemployment Insurance Rules for Determining a Claimant's Ability and Availability for Work Chapter DWD 128 CR 10-017

Basis and Purpose of the Proposed Rules

The proposed changes to the rule will narrow the test for "able to work" and broaden the test for "available for work"; clarify that all claimants must be able to work and available for work to assure that the standard is applied uniformly; and make the language of the rule consistent with the recent statutory change for a person who quits work to care for a family member.

Public Hearing Summary

A public hearing was held on May 12, 2010. There were no comments.

All comments were accepted.
