

ORDER OF STATE ELECTIONS BOARD ADOPTING ADMINISTRATIVE RULE

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Elections Board by sec. 227.014 (2), Wis. Stats., the State Elections Board hereby adopts the following rule:

Sec. El.Bd. 1.55 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is adopted to read:

El.Bd. 1.55 Reimbursement for campaign use of state vehicles. Whenever a state vehicle is used primarily for the purposes of campaigning in support of or in opposition to a candidate, there must be paid to the state treasurer the mileage fees specified in sec. 20.916 (4)(a), Stats., or in the case of aircraft, an equitable fee determined by the secretary of administration. The obligation to reimburse the state shall be included on the campaign finance report covering the period during which the obligation was incurred.

The rule contained herein shall take effect as provided in sec. 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats.
