ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

.....
 IN THE MATTER OF amending s. NR 25.05(1)(g) .
 and creating s. NR 25.05(1)(gm) of the .
 Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to . F-36-84
 commercial fishing for carp in Green Bay and .
 Lake Michigan .

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

The amending of s. NR 25.05(1)(g), Wis. Adm. Code, removes the reference to carp as part of a group of fish that are available for commercial harvest at all times in all outlying waters.

The creation of s. NR 25.05(1)(gm), Wis. Adm. Code, eliminates the open season for commercial harvest of carp from Green Bay and Lake Michigan, while continuing to allow commercial harvest in Lake Superior. The reason for the closure in Lake Michigan and Green Bay is that the level of contaminants (PCB's) in carp exceed the limits established by the Federal Food and Drug Administration as being safe for human consumption. Harvest of carp for other legal uses will be permitted under s. 29.625, Stats.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 23.09(2), 23.11(1), 29.02(1), 29.085, 29.174, 29.33, 29.625, and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends and creates rules interpreting ss. 23.09(2), 23.11(1), 29.02(1), 29.085, 29.174, 29.33 and 29.625, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 25.05(1)(g) is amended to read:

Species	A Green Bay	B Lake Michigan	C Lake Superior
(g) Alewives, bullheads, burbot, carp, catfish, gizzard shad, suckers, menominees, smelt, white bass	At all times	At all times	At all times

SECTION 2. NR 25.05(1)(gm) is created to read:

Species	A Green Bay	B Lake Michigan	C Lake Superior
(gm) Carp	No open season except by permit issued under s. 29.625, Stats.	No open season except by permit issued under s. 29.625, Stats.	At all times

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on September 26, 1984.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.026(1)(intro.), Stats.

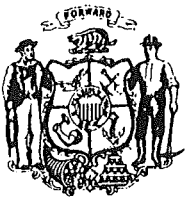
