ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER of amending s. NR 80.02(1) |
of the Wisconsin Administrative Code |
pertaining to permits for limited use |
pesticides

P-15-84

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Compliance with 1983 Wisconsin Act 91 requires a specific response time for DNR be included in the administrative code for each permit program. The time limitation in ch. NR 80 (Use of Pesticides on Land and Water Areas of the State of Wisconsin) is vague. Section NR 80.02(1) is being amended to specify a response within 15 working days.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.29(4), 227.0105 and 227.02(1)(e), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules interpreting s. 29.29(4), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 80.02(1) is amended to read:

NR 80.02(1) Except as noted in section s. NR 80.03 (exemptions) any person desiring to use a limited use pesticide in the state shall obtain a permit from the secretary of the department or the secretary's designated agent who will act after recommendation of the pesticide review board. The information furnished in an application for a permit shall include the description of the area to be treated, interval or calendar period when such treatment shall be made, number of applications, purpose of treatment, pesticide to be used, method of application and rate of application. ~~This information shall be submitted at least two weeks in advance of the proposed treatment intervals. Where circumstances require, applications may be submitted by telegraph, telephone or special delivery mail and the 2-week advance notice requirement may be waived by the secretary.~~ Upon receipt of a completed application, the department shall approve or deny the request within

15 business days. Denials shall be in writing stating reasons for the denial. In emergencies, department action shall be expedited and applications may be submitted by telegraph, telephone or special delivery mail. Permit application forms may be obtained from the department.


The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on August 22, 1984.

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
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Dear Mr. Prestegard:
