EXECUTIVE ORDER #175

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin May Be Flown at Half-Staff in Sawyer County In Memory of Rick L. Wampole, President of the Hayward Veterans Association

WHEREAS, on Thursday, September 17, 2015, Rick L. Wampole, the President of the Hayward Veterans Association, passed away; and

WHEREAS, Rick L. Wampole served his nation and his community as a member of the United States Navy, a Police Officer, an Army National Guard Recruiter, an active member of the American Legion, and President of the Hayward Veterans Association in Hayward, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, Rick L. Wampole leaves behind a legacy of service, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his death; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service with military honors will be held for Rick L. Wampole in Hayward, Wisconsin, on Tuesday, September 22, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the local community has petitioned the Office of the Governor to permit the lowering of the flags in Sawyer County on the day of the memorial service;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby authorize that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin may be flown at half-staff in Sawyer County beginning at sunrise on **Tuesday, September 22, 2015**, and ending at sunset on that date.
