

EXECUTIVE ORDER #221

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Deputy Dan Glaze of the Rusk County Sheriff's Office

WHEREAS, on Saturday, October 29, 2016, Deputy Dan Glaze, a deputy with the Rusk County Sheriff's Office, died in the line of duty in a tragic shooting at the age of thirty-three; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Dan Glaze served as a law enforcement officer for seven years including as a deputy with the Rusk County Sheriff's Office since 2015; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Dan Glaze leaves behind an honorable legacy of service to his community and his state, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his death; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Dan Glaze will be laid to rest following a memorial service in Cameron, Wisconsin, on Friday, November 4, 2016;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning at sunrise on Friday, November 4, 2016, and ending at sunset on that date.
