EXECUTIVE ORDER #233

**Relating to an Order for the Flag of the United States and the
Flag of the State of Wisconsin to be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for
Representative Tom Larson**

WHEREAS, on February 18, 2017, Representative Tom Larson passed away at the age of 69, following a battle with cancer; and

WHEREAS, Representative Tom Larson served in the Wisconsin State Assembly from 2011 until 2017, representing the people of the 67th Assembly District; and

WHEREAS, prior to his service in the Wisconsin State Assembly, Representative Tom Larson was the owner and Vice President of Bear Valley Electric; and

WHEREAS, Representative Tom Larson was also very active in his community participating in the Colfax Kiwanis, Menomonie Chamber of Commerce, Chippewa Falls Chamber of Commerce, and was a longtime member of the Bloomer Baptist Church; and

WHEREAS, Representative Tom Larson was a dedicated public servant, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his passing; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Representative Tom Larson on Saturday, March 4, 2017;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin, beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, March 4, 2017**, and ending at sunset on that date.
