**EXECUTIVE ORDER #247**

**Relating to an Order for the Flag of the United States and the  
Flag of the State of Wisconsin to be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for  
Senator Theodore J. "Ted" Kanavas**

**WHEREAS**, on July 3, 2017, Senator Ted Kanavas passed away at the age of 56, following a battle with cancer; and

**WHEREAS**, Senator Ted Kanavas served in the Wisconsin State Senate from 2001 until 2011, representing the people of the 33rd Senate District; and

**WHEREAS**, prior to his service in the Wisconsin State Senate, Senator Ted Kanavas served on the Elmbrook School Board from 1999 until 2002 and participated in both the Elmbrook Historical Society and Greater Brookfield Chamber of Commerce; and

**WHEREAS**, Senator Ted Kanavas was also a founding member of Premier Software Technologies and was the co-founder of Michael Best Strategies in 2014, a lobbying branch of the Michael Best & Friedrich law firm; and

**WHEREAS**, Senator Ted Kanavas was a devoted husband to Mary, father to Kelly, Nick, and Kate, and coach to the Brookfield Bulldogs; and

**WHEREAS**, Senator Ted Kanavas was a dedicated public servant, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his passing; and

**WHEREAS**, a memorial service will be held for Senator Ted Kanavas on Saturday, July 8, 2017;


