EXECUTIVE ORDER #276

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for PFC Ethan Barclay-Weberpal of the United States Marine Corps

WHEREAS, on January 16, 2018, PFC Ethan Barclay-Weberpal, a member of the United States Marine Corps and a native of Janesville, Wisconsin, passed away unexpectedly at Camp Pendleton, California; and

WHEREAS, PFC Ethan Barclay-Weberpal faithfully served the people of the State of Wisconsin and the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of PFC Ethan Barclay-Weberpal; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for PFC Ethan Barclay-Weberpal on Monday, January 29, 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution, the laws of this State, and by federal law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning at sunrise on **Monday, January 29, 2018** and ending at sunset on that date.
