Bike Safety Refresher: With more people out biking, remember safety along our roadways requires everyone to do their part.

Bicyclists:

- 🚦 Obey traffic laws
- 🚗 Ride in the same direction as traffic
- ➡️ Ride as far right as practical
- 🚗 Watch for vehicle doors opening

Motorists:

- 🚗 Slow down
- 🚗 Be alert and courteous
- ➡️ Stay at least three feet from bicyclists
- 🚗 Be careful not to turn into bicyclists' path
