

## EXECUTIVE ORDER #101

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Fire Chief Donald Edwin Kittelson of the Clayton Volunteer Fire Department

**WHEREAS,** on December 17, 2020, Fire Chief Donald Edwin Kittelson, of Clayton, passed away after contracting COVID-19 in the line of duty;

**WHEREAS,** Fire Chief Donald Edwin Kittelson proudly served his community as a volunteer firefighter for more than 34 years;

**WHEREAS,** Fire Chief Donald Edwin Kittelson was a pillar of the community, readily sharing his knowledge and enthusiasm for firefighting with the next generation;

**WHEREAS,** Fire Chief Donald Edwin Kittelson was a loving husband, father, son, and brother, a doting grandfather, a mentor to many, and a friend to the community;

**WHEREAS,** a celebration of life will be held for Fire Chief Donald Edwin Kittelson on Saturday, January 2, 2021, in Clayton, Wisconsin; and

**WHEREAS,** the people of the State of Wisconsin are forever grateful for the service, selflessness, and sacrifice of Fire Chief Donald Edwin Kittelson of the Clayton Volunteer Fire Department.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS,** Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning on **Saturday, January 2, 2021**, and ending at sunset on that day.
