1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 7: before “and providing a penalty” insert “public health
3 campaign for prevention of tobacco and electronic cigarette use, a grant program to
4 support organizations working on youth vaping and cessation services, making an
5 appropriation.”.

6 **2.** Page 8, line 21: after that line insert:

7 “**SECTION 15e.** 255.15 (3) (d) of the statutes is created to read:

8 255.15 (3) (d) From the appropriation under s. 20.435 (1) (fm), the department
9 may develop and implement a public health campaign aimed at the prevention of
10 initiation of tobacco and electronic cigarette use and may award grants for local and
11 regional organizations working on youth vaping and providing cessation services.
