**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 518**

January 7, 2020 - Offered by Senator KOOYENGA.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 5: after “licenses,” insert “continuing education requirements
3 for funeral directors,”.

4 **2.** Page 1, line 5: delete “and”.

5 **3.** Page 1, line 6: after “procedures” insert “, and granting rule-making
6 authority”.

7 **4.** Page 2, line 15: after that line insert:

8 “**SECTION 3g.** 445.06 of the statutes is renumbered 445.06 (1) and amended to
9 read:

10 445.06 (1) The renewal date for a funeral director’s license is specified under
11 s. 440.08 (2) (a), and the renewal fee for such license is determined by the department
12 under s. 440.03 (9) (a). ~~Before any renewal license is delivered to any licensed funeral~~
13 ~~director, proof must be furnished by~~

1 (2) In order to renew a license under this chapter, the applicant shall furnish
2 proof, to the satisfaction of the examining board, that of all of the following:

3 (a) That the applicant is doing business at a recognized funeral establishment.
4 ~~The applicant must also furnish proof of completion of at least 15 hours of~~

5 (b) That the applicant has satisfied the applicable continuing education during
6 ~~the previous 2-year licensure period, except that new licensees are exempt from this~~
7 ~~requirement during the time between initial licensure and commencement of a full~~
8 ~~2-year licensure period requirements under s. 445.07.~~

9 **SECTION 3r.** 445.07 of the statutes is created to read:

10 **445.07 Continuing education.** (1) In order to renew a license under this
11 chapter, an applicant shall, except as provided in sub. (2), furnish proof of having
12 satisfied the following:

13 (a) For the renewal of a license that expires on the first renewal date after the
14 date on which the examining board initially granted the license, completion of 4
15 hours of continuing education subsequent to the date the applicant was granted the
16 initial license. The examining board shall, in the rules promulgated under sub. (3),
17 specify permitted or required subjects for the continuing education under this
18 paragraph, which shall be subjects that the examining board determines prepare a
19 new licensee for practice as a funeral director.

20 (b) For each renewal subsequent to the renewal described in par. (a),
21 completion of 15 hours of continuing education in the previous 2-year licensure
22 period.

23 **(2)** (a) The examining board may waive the requirement under sub. (1) (a) in
24 cases where the examining board is satisfied that an applicant would be unable to
25 satisfy the requirement prior to the renewal date.
