**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 302**

January 16, 2024 - Offered by Senator QUINN.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute  
2           amendment 1, as follows:

3           **1.** Page 2, line 12: on lines 12 and 24, after “(b)” insert “or (bm)”.

4           **2.** Page 3, line 7: on lines 7 and 10, after “(b)” insert “or (bm)”.

5           **3.** Page 4, line 10: after “of” insert “individual or”.

6           **4.** Page 4, line 24: after that line insert:

7           “(bm) “Qualified data center” also means one or more buildings or an array of  
8           connected buildings owned, leased, or operated by the same business entity, as  
9           defined in s. 13.62 (5), or its affiliate and for which all of the following apply:

10           1. The buildings are rehabilitated or constructed to house a group of individual  
11           or networked server computers in one physical location or multiple locations in order  
12           to provide an owner, operator, or tenant the opportunity to rent or own space, utilities

1 and other vital resources such as cooling capacity, enhanced security features, or the  
2 ability to procure infrastructure, platforms, software, and other managed services.

3 2. The buildings rehabilitated or constructed as provided in subd. 1. are at least  
4 25,000 square feet and create a minimum qualified investment in this state, in the  
5 aggregate, of at least \$20,000,000 within 5 years from the date on which the  
6 corporation certifies the data center and the data center owner, operator, and tenants  
7 as eligible to claim the exemption under s. 77.54 (70). For purposes of this  
8 subdivision, rehabilitation or construction costs include all eligible data center costs  
9 incurred by the facility owner, operator, and tenants, as certified by the corporation.

10 (bn) “Qualified data center” does not include buildings used for or to facilitate  
11 the creation of cryptocurrencies and the process used to verify and secure  
12 cryptocurrency transactions and blockchains.”

13 **5.** Page 5, line 8: after “(b)” insert “or (bm)”.

14 **6.** Page 5, line 13: on lines 13 and 18, after “(b) 2.” insert “or (bm) 2.”.
