## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 58

March 3, 2023 - Offered by Representative MICHALSKI.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
<b>2</b>	${f l.}$ Page 1, line 4: delete ", the court" and substitute "and the person is subject
3	to this section because he or she was convicted of a violent felony, then,
4	notwithstanding sub. (1m), the person is guilty of a Class F felony and the court".
5	<b>2.</b> Page 2, line 3: after that line insert:
6	"SECTION 1m. 941.29 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
7	941.29(5)(a) Has received a pardon with respect to the crime or felony specified
8	in sub. (1m), (4g), or (4m) and has been expressly authorized to possess a firearm
9	under 18 USC app. 1203; or
10	<b>SECTION 1p.</b> 973.176 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
11	973.176 (1) FIREARM POSSESSION. Whenever a court imposes a sentence or
12	places a defendant on probation regarding a felony conviction, the court shall inform

- 1 the defendant of the requirements and penalties applicable to him or her under s.
- 2 941.29 (1m), (4g), or (4m), whichever is applicable.".
