**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 960**

February 19, 2024 - Offered by Representative KITCHENS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 16: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 6g.** 968.373 (8) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

4 968.373 (8) (c) If the location of a communications device is disclosed to a law  
5 enforcement agency under par. (b) 2. or 3., the provider of electronic communication  
6 services shall notify the customer or subscriber of the information disclosure within  
7 30 days after the call for emergency services or the emergency situation, or when any  
8 case that resulted from the call for emergency services or the emergency situation  
9 has resolved, whichever is later.

10 **SECTION 6m.** 968.373 (8g) of the statutes is created to read:

11 968.373 (8g) COURT REVIEW. If the location of a communications device is  
12 disclosed to a law enforcement agency under sub. (8) (b) 2. or 3. and evidence of  
13 criminal activity was obtained as a result of the disclosure, the law enforcement

1 agency shall, within 3 days of the disclosure, apply to a judge for an order  
2 retroactively authorizing the emergency disclosure. The application under this  
3 subsection shall set forth the facts giving rise to the emergency disclosure, and the  
4 judge shall promptly issue an order determining whether the emergency disclosure  
5 was necessary. If the judge determines that the disclosure was not necessary, the  
6 judge shall order that the evidence be suppressed in any criminal proceeding on the  
7 grounds that the evidence was unlawfully obtained, and order immediate  
8 notification under sub. (8) (c).”.
