ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING, AMENDING, AND REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

The Wisconsin Natural Resources Board proposes an order to amend NR 10.102(1)(d); to repeal and recreate NR 10.30 and to create NR 10.102(1)(f) relating to bear hunting.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(3) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.174(2) and 29.1085, Stats.

In this order:

Section 1. Black bear population goals - updates population goals and creates a goal for subunit A1.

Section 2. <u>Black bear harvest permits</u> - requires that harvest permits issued for a permanent subzone be valid only for that subzone.

Section 3. Black bear subzone - establishes a new permanent subzone.

SECTION 1. NR 10.102(1)(d) is amended to read:

NR 10.102(1)(d) Population goals. The fall pre-hunt bear population goal is as follows:



SECTION 2. NR 10.102(1)(f) is created to read:

NR 10.102(1)(f) Permanent bear harvest subzones. Permits for subzones shall be used only in the subzone.

SECTION 3. NR 10.30 is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 10.30 BLACK BEAR HUNTING ZONES. Black bear hunting zones are established as designated on the following map:
