# PROPOSED ORDER OF THE STATE PUBLIC DEFENDER CREATING A RULE

The Wisconsin state public defender board proposes an order to amend PD 3.02 (1), relating to the cost of retained counsel.

## **Analysis By Agency:**

The proposed amendment to PD 3.02 (1) is technical in nature, and is necessary to make the rule consistent with current agency practice. Presently, the category related to Class A and B felonies in the "cost of retained counsel" table makes reference to "armed" Class A and B felonies. Current agency practice requires deletion of the term "armed." The category should correctly state "other Class A & Class B felony."

#### Section 1.

PD 3.02 (1) is amended to read:

PD 3.02 Cost of retained counsel. (1) The "anticipated cost of retaining counsel," shall be determined by this schedule, except as provided by sub. (2):
