Current rules for the Examining Board of Professional Geologists, Hydrologists and Soil Scientists do not permit the formation of a rules committee to act for the board in rule-making proceedings. The objective of the rule is to authorize the board to form a rules committee. The board may currently approve and adopt rules proposed by any section of the board. A rules committee would better enable the board to develop and refine rules proposed by the sections or the board. This would meet the objective of standardizing the rules development process between the sections of the board and provide for greater efficiency. The proposed rule would consist of two sections. The first section would permit the board to

approve and adopt rules proposed by any section of the board. The second section would define the

composition of a rules committee and provide that the rules committee shall act for the board in
