



2019 ASSEMBLY BILL 418

September 5, 2019 - Introduced by Representatives SUBECK, SARGENT, C. TAYLOR, ANDERSON, BILLINGS, CROWLEY, EMERSON, KOLSTE and SINICKI, cosponsored by Senators L. TAYLOR, RISSER, JOHNSON and LARSON. Referred to Committee on Small Business Development.

1 **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 175.37 (1); *to amend* 175.37 (title) and 175.37
2 (2); and *to create* 175.37 (1) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** containers or
3 trigger locks provided at a firearm sale and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires a person who commercially sells or transfers a firearm to provide the purchaser or transferee with either a secure, lockable container that is designed to store a firearm or a trigger lock for the firearm. A seller or transferor who violates this requirement is subject to a fine of up to \$500 or imprisonment for up to 30 days, or both.

Because this bill creates a new crime or revises a penalty for an existing crime, the Joint Review Committee on Criminal Penalties may be requested to prepare a report.
