### **2019 ASSEMBLY BILL 459**

September 18, 2019 – Introduced by Representatives THIESFELDT, VRUWINK, BALLWEG, BOWEN, BROSTOFF, GUNDRUM, JAMES, HAYWOOD, KRUG, KUGLITSCH, MURSAU, L. MYERS, RAMTHUN, SANFELIPPO, SKOWRONSKI, TUSLER and DITTRICH, cosponsored by Senators Olsen, Johnson, Nass, Carpenter, Jacque, MARKLEIN, L. TAYLOR and WANGGAARD. Referred to Committee on State Affairs.

AN ACT to create 115.28 (56), 118.40 (2r) (b) 2. L., 118.40 (2x) (b) 2. L., 118.60 (2) (a) 9., 119.23 (2) (a) 9. and 121.02 (1) (k) 4. of the statutes; relating to: incorporating cursive writing into the state model English language arts standards and requiring cursive writing in elementary grades.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the state superintendent of public instruction to incorporate cursive writing into the model academic standards for English language arts. This bill also requires a school board, independent charter school, and private school participating in a parental choice program to include cursive writing in its respective curriculum for the elementary grades. Specifically, each elementary school curriculum must include the objective that pupils be able to write legibly in cursive by the end of fifth grade.

15	SECTION 5. 119.23 (2) (a) 9. of the statutes is created to read:
16	119.23 (2) (a) 9. If the private school operates elementary grades, a
17	requirement that the private school's curriculum include the academic objective in
18	s. 121.02 (1) (k) 4.
19	<b>SECTION 6.</b> 121.02 (1) (k) 4. of the statutes is created to read:
20	121.02 (1) (k) 4. By July 1, 2020, include in a language arts curriculum plan
21	under this paragraph the academic objective that pupils be able to write legibly in
22	cursive by the end of grade 5. This subdivision does not apply to union high school
23	districts.
