- AN ACT *to create* 20.292 (1) (em) and 38.04 (33) of the statutes; **relating to:**grants to technical college districts for nurse aide training and making an
- 3 appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Technical College System Board to make grants to technical college district boards in areas with nurse aide shortages to expand access to nurse aide training.
