



## 2019 SENATE BILL 23

February 8, 2019 - Introduced by Senator CARPENTER, cosponsored by Representatives SINICKI, VRUWINK, BOWEN and EMERSON. Referred to Committee on Government Operations, Technology and Consumer Protection.

1     **AN ACT to create** 13.086 of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring a supermajority  
2             vote for bills overturning local government policies, ordinances, resolutions,  
3             and regulations.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill provides that no house of the legislature may pass a bill that overturns any local government policy, ordinance, resolution, or regulation unless the bill is approved by two-thirds of those members present and voting. The bill applies to policies, ordinances, resolutions, and regulations of school districts, counties, cities, villages, and towns.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

4             **SECTION 1.** 13.086 of the statutes is created to read:  
5             **13.086 Bills overturning local government policies, ordinances,**  
6             **resolutions, and regulations. (1)** In this section, “local government” means a  
7             school district, county, city, village, or town.
