SUBJECT: Treatment of Revenues Under Proposed Constitutional Limitation: City of Madison,

Dane County, and Madison Metropolitan School District

The attached tables report the estimated treatment of revenues for the City of Madison and for Dane County in 2004 and for the Madison Metropolitan School district in 2003-04 under the proposed constitutional amendment to limit revenues (AJR 77 and SJR 63).

The joint resolutions would limit the year-to-year increases in certain revenues and would specifically exclude certain other revenues from the limitation. Revenues subject to the limitation would include taxes, fees, licenses, permits, assessments, fines and forfeitures imposed by local governments. In addition, most moneys received from bonds, except for moneys generated from municipal economic development bonds, from the refinancing of bonds, or from short-term cash flow borrowing, would be subject to the limitation. Revenues specifically excluded from the limitation would include moneys used for debt service on municipal economic development bonds, or intergovernmental revenues received from the federal, state, or local governments, or moneys from gifts, damage awards, or property sales. In addition, moneys received for the operation of a telephone, gas, electric, or water utility, or a hospital, nursing home, or assisted living facility, or from fees imposed for airport or mass transit systems would be excluded from the control.

You asked that the definitions in the joint resolutions be applied to the revenues actually received by the City of Madison and by Dane County in 2004. Based on the financial report form that every municipality and county is required to file with the Department of Revenue (DOR), the attached tables list the revenue categories that included revenues from at least one of the state's 1,851 municipalities or one of the state's 72 counties in 2004. In the two right-hand columns, the tables display the revenues received by the City of Madison and Dane County according to whether the revenues would be subject to the limitation or excluded from the limitation. The DOR report

does not provide a sufficient level of detail to comprehensively reflect the treatment under the joint resolutions. For example, tax increments are shown as not being subject to the limitation since these are generally used to retire bonds used to finance improvements that presumably would be considered part of an economic development. Some categories could include both revenues that are included under the control and excluded from the control. In those cases, the category is included under the column where the majority of the revenues would be included, or, in the case of unspecified "miscellaneous" or "other" revenue categories, under the not subject to limitation column. In addition, the joint resolutions would allow the Legislature to exclude certain other categories of revenues from the control, and those revenue categories are unknown at this time.

Attachment 1 differs from Attachment 2 in that the latter reflects revenues recorded in internal service funds, while Attachment 1 does not. The Department of Revenue instructs local governments to use internal service funds to account for services performed by a department or agency of the local government for another department or agency of the same local government or for a department or agency of another government. In addition, counties may use internal service funds to account for the operations of their county highway departments. This treatment facilitates reporting under state transportation aids programs. Due to this use, Attachment 2 (Dane County) includes revenues recorded in highway and non-highway internal service funds.

Attachment 3 applies the definitions of revenue under the joint resolutions to the revenues received by the Madison Metropolitan School District in 2003-04. The categories shown in Attachment 3 are based on the revenue codes used by school districts under the uniform financial fund accounting system prescribed by the Department of Public Instruction. The revenue categories listed are those that apply generally to all districts and for which at least one district in the state reported revenue in 2003-04. Revenues resulting from interfund transfers are excluded from the attachment. Similar to the first two attachments, Attachment 3 displays the revenues received by the Madison Metropolitan School District according to whether they would be subject to or excluded from the limitation.
