3 **“SECTION 8m. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) Notwithstanding s. 165.08 (1), the attorney general may, with the approval  
5 of the governor, withdraw or alter the state’s litigation position in any pending  
6 litigation in which the state is involved on the effective date of this subsection  
7 relating to the provisions of the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act,  
8 P.L. 111-148.”.
