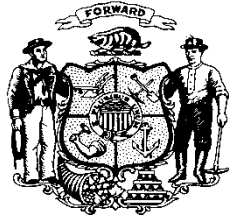

The department also requests a one-time transfer of \$870,500 GPR in fiscal year 2023-24 from its services for drunken driving offenders appropriation under s. 20.410(1)(bd) to its corrections contracts and agreements appropriation under s. 20.410(1)(ab) to address a projected shortfall related to contract beds.
