2023 Senate Bill 172

Assembly Amendment 1

2023 SENATE BILL 172

Senate Bill 172 arose out of the Legislative Council Study Committee on Increasing Offender Employment Opportunities. The bill requires the Department of Corrections (DOC) to contract with at least one nonprofit organization, for-profit entity, or public agency to establish a community reentry center.

A community reentry center is a community site offering individuals who are being released from prison initial points of contact for each of the following: health services, identification document services, financial services, housing services, employment services, education services, and DOC supervision services. The bill creates an appropriation for community reentry centers, but does not appropriate any funds.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 deletes the appropriation for community reentry centers created in the bill.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representative Born on February 21, 2024. On February 22, 2024, the Assembly adopted the amendment and concurred in Senate Bill 172, as amended.
