2023 Senate Bill 773

Senate Amendment 1

2023 SENATE BILL 773

2023 Senate Bill 773 makes a number of changes to activities and powers of credit union, bank, savings bank and savings and loan institutions, including the creation of a crime of interference with an automated teller machine (ATM). Under the bill, whoever intentionally causes impairment or interruption of use, in whole or in part, of a financial institution's ATM or customer bank communications terminal is guilty of a Class H felony.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 deletes the requirement that the ATM or customer bank communications terminal belong to a financial institution for interference with such a machine to qualify as a crime.

BILL HISTORY

Senate Amendment 1 was offered by Senator Stafsholt on January 3, 2024. The Senate Committee on Financial Institutions and Sporting Heritage recommended both the adoption of Senate Amendment 1, and passage of Senate Bill 773 as amended, by votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0; on January 5, 2024.
