Voting Motion:

The Joint Legislative Audit Committee (Committee) will cast votes in executive session under the following rules:

- A majority of the Committee constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business. For the purpose of determining a quorum of the committee necessary to transact business, and with the consent of the Committee co-chairpersons, a member who is connected to a meeting of the Committee via teleconference is considered present.
- If a vote is taken by roll call, the roll may be held open for absent members until 4:30 p.m. the day of the Committee meeting or until the adjournment of the Committee, whichever is later; or at the discretion of the Committee co-chairs if they grant a longer period. A member who votes following the adjournment of the Committee shall be recorded as absent, but voting, and the vote may affect the outcome of the Committee's decision.
- The committee may also vote by paper ballot. If the co-chairpersons of the committee elect to vote by ballot, public notice shall be posted on the bulletin board of each house prior to the circulation of the ballot. The notice shall indicate when the ballot will be circulated and the subject matter and proposed action to be considered by the committee.
