### CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 19-079

#### Comments

#### **2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code**

- a. The italics should be removed from s. DHS 144.02 (21) (g).
- b. The title to s. DHS 144.03 (9) is missing the second reference to the years 2008-09, which should appear stricken-through before the second reference to the 2020-2021 school year. Similarly, the words “basic and booster” should appear stricken-through in s. DHS 144.03 (2) (a).
- c. Does the department intend to repeal all of the footnotes to Table 144.03-A?
- d. Section DHS 144.03 (2) (g) states that the first dose of Var shall be “administered” by a certain deadline and that the second dose shall be “received” by a different deadline. Is there a reason the department chose to use these terms? It appears that, for enforcement purposes, it would be clearer if the rule consistently placed the responsibility on the child to receive the vaccination rather than on the provider to administer it. The department should review the rule generally for consistency in this type of terminology.
- e. Section DHS 144.03 (2) (h) should refer to students between the ages of 11 and 15 years.
- f. Section DHS 144.03 (3) appears to be unnecessary, since the requirement to obtain the meningitis vaccinations is already stated in the table.
