Re: Section Ins 9.01, 9.07, 9.20, 9.25, 9.32, 9.33, 9.41 and 9.42, Wis. Adm. Code, relating to defined network plans, preferred provider plans, limited service health organizations and limited scope plans and affecting small businesses.

Dear Senator Kapanke:

I am submitting germane modifications to this proposed rule for your consideration under s. 227.19(4)(b)2., Wis. Stat. It is necessary to modify the rule as follows:

1. Modify Section 9 to include repeal of s. Ins 9.32 (2) (c) and (e).
2. Modify Section 11 to read:

Ins 9.33 **Enrollee election of nonparticipating provider reimbursement.** Nothing in s. Ins 9.32 changes the reimbursement payable or the amounts due, including co-payments, coinsurance, deductibles and other cost-sharing provisions form an enrollee when the enrollee of a preferred provider plan that is not a defined network plan elects to utilize the services of a non-participating provider when a participating provider is available in accordance with s. Ins 9.32 (a) and (b) and the requirements of s. Ins 9.32 (2) (c) and (d), ~~including the information from the participating provider,~~ are provided to the enrollee.

3. Modify Sections 7, 10, 13, 14, 15 to remove reference to suspension by JCRAR.
