TO WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STAFF**

Rule Submittal Date

On January 9, 2014, the Wisconsin Department of Administration submitted a proposed rule order to amend Adm 2 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code to the Wisconsin Legislative Council Rules Clearinghouse.

The Statement of Scope for this rule, SS 131-13, was approved by the Governor on October 8, 2013, published in Register No. 694 on October 31, 2013, and approved by Department of Administration Secretary Mike Huebsch on November 13, 2013.

Subject

Statutory Authority: ss. 16.004(1), 16.846(1)(a) and 227.11, Stats

Statutes Interpreted: s.16.846, Stats

The objective of the rule is to obtain compliance regarding use of state facilities including the Capitol building. This objective will be achieved by codifying historical department practices and more clearly detailing certain provisions of the administrative code as informed by judicial interpretations.

Agency Procedure for Promulgation

A public hearing is required and will be scheduled at a future date. The organizational unit responsible for promulgation of the proposed rules is the Division of Legal Services.
