The purpose of the rule is to bring the rule in compliance with 2013 Wisconsin Act 114 and to update the examination requirements. 2013 Wisconsin Act 114 prohibits the board from requiring a person to complete any postsecondary education before the person is eligible to take an examination for a credential. The proposed rule revises the application rules to allow for the examination to be taken prior to completion of the education. The proposed rule also updates and clarifies the examination requirements including the removal of outdated and obsolete provisions.
