The purpose of the proposed rule is to remove [123]ioflupane from scheduling as a controlled substance. On September 11, 2015, a final rule was published in the Federal Register removing [123]ioflupane from the federal Controlled Substances Act. The Controlled Substances Board took Affirmative Action on October 13, 2015 to similarly treat [123]ioflupane under chapter 961, Stats effective on October 19, 2015 and expires upon promulgation of a final rule.
