CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 17-025
CHAPTER PI 34
TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM APPROVAL AND LICENSES

Analysis by the Department of Public Instruction

Statutory authority: s. 115.28 (7) (a), Stats.

Statute interpreted: ss. 115.28 (7) (a) and 118.191, Stats.

The proposed technical change aligns the rules governing teacher licensure with changes in statute resulting from 2015 Wisconsin Act 259 with respect to experience-based licensure for vocational education subjects.

A list of the persons who appeared or registered for or against the proposed rule at a public hearing:

As provided in s. 227.16 (2) (b), Stats., there is no requirement that a public hearing be held for this rule because the proposed rule brings an existing rule into conformity with a statute that has been changed.
