IV. DETAILED STATEMENT EXPLAINING THE BASIS AND PURPOSE OF THE PROPOSED RULE, INCLUDING HOW THE PROPOSED RULE ADVANCES RELEVANT STATUTORY GOALS OR PURPOSES:

The purpose of the proposed rule is to schedule MT-45 as a schedule I controlled substance. On December 13, 2017, a final rule was published in the Federal Register placing MT-45 into schedule I of the federal Controlled Substances Act. The Controlled Substances Board took Affirmative Action on January 16, 2018 to similarly treat MT-45 under chapter 961, Stats effective on January 22, 2018 and expires upon promulgation of a final rule. It is in the best interest of Wisconsin citizens to schedule drugs which are determined to be controlled substances.
