

NOTICE OF SUBMITTAL TO LEGISLATURE

Agency: Chiropractic Examining Board Clearinghouse Rule: 18-105

On August 12, 2019, the Chiropractic Examining Board submitted CR 18-105, a proposed rule in final draft form, to the chief clerk of each house of the Legislature. On November 21, 2019, the Chiropractic Examining Board recalled the rule pursuant to s. 227.19 (4) (b) 4., Stats. With this Notice, the Chiropractic Examining Board is resubmitting CR 18-105, a proposed rule in final draft form with germane modification, to the chief clerk of each house of the Legislature pursuant to s. 227.19 (4) (b) 4., Stats. The germane modification revises ss. Chir 4.04 (3) and 10.03 to reflect s. 446.02 (7) (d), Stats., which provides a chiropractor may delegate x-ray services only to a chiropractic radiological technician or a health care professional acting within the scope of the health care professional's license, registration, or certification.

The Governor approved the proposed rule under sec. 227.185, Stats., on August 9, 2019.
