Dear Senate Chief Clerk's Office:

On November 5, 2019, the Department of Public Instruction submitted CR 19-111, relating to changes to licensure for educational interpreters, to the Legislature. Since then, the Department of Public Instruction identified a germane modification to CR 19-111 which is necessary for the implementation of the proposed rule. The germane modification is a technical revision to s. PI 34.086 (3) (a) 1. to recognize changes to licensure of interpreters made by the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS). This modification will allow the Department of Public Instruction to continue to recognize DSPS licenses in this area as an alternative condition for receiving an educational interpreter license issued by the State Superintendent.

Accordingly, this letter serves as notice of the Department of Public Instruction recalling CR 19-111 from the chief clerk of each house of the legislature and resubmitting it with a germane modification, pursuant to s. 227.19 (4) (b) 3m., Stats.
