**IV. DETAILED STATEMENT EXPLAINING THE BASIS AND PURPOSE OF THE PROPOSED RULE, INCLUDING HOW THE PROPOSED RULE ADVANCES RELEVANT STATUTORY GOALS OR PURPOSES:**

On July 18, 2019, the Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration published its final rule in the Federal Register placing N-Ethylhexedrone, a-PHP, 4-MEAP, MPHP, PV8 and 4-chloro-a-PVP into Schedule I of the federal Controlled Substances Act.

The Controlled Substances Board did not receive an objection to treating N-Ethylhexedrone, a-PHP, 4-MEAP, MPHP, PV8 and 4-chloro-a-PVP as a schedule I controlled substance under ch. 961, Stats., based upon the federal scheduling. The Controlled Substances Board took affirmative action on August 12, 2019 to similarly treat N-Ethylhexedrone, a-PHP, 4-MEAP, MPHP, PV8 and 4-chloro-a-PVP under chapter 961 effective August 19, 2019 to allow for publication in the Administrative Register. The Affirmative Action Order will expire upon promulgation of a final rule. It is in the best interest of Wisconsin citizens to schedule drugs which are determined to be controlled substances.

**V. SUMMARY OF PUBLIC COMMENTS AND THE BOARD'S RESPONSES, EXPLANATION OF MODIFICATIONS TO PROPOSED RULES PROMPTED BY PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

Per s. 961.11(4), Stats., if no objection is made, the board shall promulgate a final rule for which notice of proposed rulemaking is omitted. Therefore, the Board did not hold a public hearing.
