NOTICE IS GIVEN, pursuant to s. 227.19 (2), Stats., that the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin is submitting a final draft of proposed rules, Clearinghouse Rule No. 20-083, to the chief clerk of the Senate and Assembly. The proposed rule relates to allowing an electric provider, or customer or member of an electric provider, to create a renewable resource credit for heat that is a byproduct of a manufacturing process and is used to provide thermal energy for another purpose. The Governor's office approved the statement of scope, SS 012-19, for this rule on December 20, 2018, and the statement of scope was published in Register No. 757A3 on January 14, 2019. The Governor's office approved this rule on May 13, 2021, pursuant to s. 227.185, Stats.
