# Department of Children and Families Rule Report for Legislative Review Qualified Residential Treatment Programs DCF 61 CR 22-084

### **Basis and Purpose of the Proposed Rules**

The proposed rules provide the requirements for the establishment, certification, operation, and monitoring of, and the placement of a child in, a qualified residential treatment program under s. 48.675, Stats., as created by 2021 Wisconsin Act 42. A corresponding emergency rule, EmR2124 became effective September 29, 2021, and expires the earlier of July 1, 2023, or the effective date of the permanent rule.

### **Public Hearing Summary and Department Response**

A public hearing was held via Zoom on January 5, 2023. A summary of the comment received and the department's response is attached.

### **Department Response to Legislative Council Rules Clearinghouse Recommendations**

<u>Response to comment 3</u>: The department is retaining the definition of "Indian child" as a cross-reference to the same term in s. 48.02 (8g), Stats., to avoid possible confusion caused by a rule definition that conflicts with the Wisconsin Indian Child Welfare Act throughout ch. 48, Stats. Other comments were accepted.
