ORDER OF THE STATE BANKING DEPARTMENT AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the commissioner of banks by Section 34.03 and Chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the commissioner of banks hereby amends Section Bkg 13.03 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE to read:

"Bkg 13.03 Conditions under which public deposits may be received. Public depositories may receive and hold total public deposits in excess of the amount herein fixed provided that at all times while such excess public deposits are held the cash reserve of such public depository shall exceed the statutory cash reserve by an amount not less than the amount of such excess total public deposits, or provided that such excess or any portion thereof may be invested in U. S. Treasury Bills maturing in not more than six months from the date of such investment."

The rule contained herein shall take effect on May 1, 1964, as provided in Section 227.026 (1).
