ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER of amending s. NR 20.08 of	•
the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining	. F-1-83
to a closed turtle season	•
	•

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

A rule establishing a closed turtle season from May 1 to June 15, inclusive, each year, went into effect January 1, 1983. The rule was created to restrict harvest of turtles during the migratory periods when female turtles laid eggs. The rule did not apply to boundary waters. The rules state in part ... on inland waters other than boundary waters. By referring to inland waters under a strict interpretation of the rule, turtles were not protected during the egg laying period. The adoption of this rule will provide protection for turtles during the egg laying period which was the original intent.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.085, 29.175, 227.014(2)(a) and 227.02(1)(e), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules interpreting s. 29.175, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 20.08 is amended to read:

NR 20.08 TURTLE-TRAPS TURTLES. (a) (1) TRAPS. A maximum of 5 hoop net turtle traps are allowed with a mesh of not less than 8 inch stretch measure providing such traps are so set that not less than 2 inches of the hoops extend above the surface of the water, and float and tank type turtle traps not exceeding 4 feet square or 4 feet in diameter may be used for trapping turtles. Each such trap while in use shall have attached in such a manner as to be visible and legible at all times, a metal tag bearing the name and address of the operator of the trap and no other person may tend or operate the trap.

- (b)-A-(2) SEASONS. (a) Except on interstate boundary waters, a closed season is established on the taking of turtles from May 1 to June 15 inclusive on-inland-waters-other-than-the-boundary-waters.
- (b) There is no closed season on the taking of turtles on the interstate boundary waters.
