EXECUTIVE ORDER #239

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin May Be Flown at Half-Staff in the Village of Ashwaubenon as a Mark of Respect for Village President Michael W. Aubinger

WHEREAS, on Thursday, March 30, 2017, Village President Michael W. Aubinger of the Village of Ashwaubenon passed away at the age of 63; and

WHEREAS, Michael W. Aubinger honorably served the Village of Ashwaubenon and the State of Wisconsin during his service as Ashwaubenon Village President since 2009; and


WHEREAS, prior to his service as President of the Village of Ashwaubenon, Michael W. Aubinger was member of the Ashwaubenon School District Board from 2002 to 2011; and

WHEREAS, Michael W. Aubinger was a dedicated public servant, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his passing;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby authorize that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin may be flown at half-staff in the Village of Ashwaubenon, Wisconsin, **beginning immediately and ending at sunset on the day of interment.**
