NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to s. 115.364 (3), Stats., and interpreting s. 115.364, Stats., the Department of Public Instruction will hold a public hearing as follows to consider the promulgation of Clearinghouse Rule 18-084, creating PI 31 relating to aid for school mental health programs.
